Detailed report of the program:

The PG & Research Department of Microbiology organized an event on "Workshop on Response Surface Methodology-Satistical Tool for optimization Studies". The event started with the welcome note by Dr. P. Vidya, Head of the Department, Dwaraka Doss Goverdhan Doss Vaishnav College, Chennai. The primary objective of workshop on RSM is to determine the optimal combination of input variables that will result in the desired output response. This workshop achieves this by creating a response surface, which is a three-dimensional plot that shows how the output response changes with changes in the input variables.

Dr. M.Abirami handled the session I, she mentioned the steps involved in RSM, including experimental design, model development, and optimization. The experimental design involves selecting the appropriate factors or input variables, their levels, and their combinations. The model development involves developing mathematical equations that describe the relationship between the input variables and the output response. Finally, the optimization involves using the response surface model to identify the optimal combination of input variables that will result in the desired output response.


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Dr. V.Rajalakshmi emphasized the main advantages of RSM is that it is a cost-effective and time-efficient way to optimize complex processes. The optimization of complex processes can often require numerous experiments, which can be time-consuming and costly. RSM helps to minimize the number of experiments required by using a statistical approach to model the relationship between the input variables and the output response. She highlighted the limitations about the assumption of a quadratic response surface. This assumption may not hold true for all systems, and deviations from this assumption can lead to inaccurate results. Another limitation is the need for accurate and reliable data. Poor-quality data can lead to inaccurate models, which can produce incorrect results. Additionally, RSM cannot optimize processes that have discrete variables.

Outcome of the program: This workshop helps the student's community to explore knowledge on RSM. Participants would learn how to select appropriate factors or input variables, their levels, and their combinations.



Detailed Report

The Research Methodology Workshop was organized for two days between 19th and 20th January, 2023. The Resource person for this session was Dr. A. Alan Godfrey, Head and Assistant Professor, School of Social Work, St. Joseph's University. The Session started with the Guest Profile Reading by Mr. Lakshmanan. M of 2nd Year MSW.

The Resource person began the session by enquiring the students about the CSR internship and the key takeaways from the students during their course of CSR internship. Then he spoke about the Performance Management cycle and the use of Research and Development in the manufacturing sector. The Importance of Research was emphasized by the 4P's namely Passion, Problem, People and Place.

Then the Resource person briefed about the Social Worker's code of ethics and its significance in research studies. It is indeed important that the researcher should imply the code of ethics during his research study such as Informed consent, Confidentiality, Professional relationship etc. The resource person also touched upon the Role of IT industries in developing software for the payroll and other functions which also covers the front-end and back-end software work.

The Resource person then moved on to the Review of Literature. The Literature Reviews provide the background and justification for the study. The Resource person emphasized that the aim of any literature review is to summarize and synthesize the arguments and ideas of existing knowledge in a particular field without adding any new contributions. Being built on existing knowledge they help the researcher to even turn the wheels of the topic of research. The Resource person provided a basic format of the Review of Literature as given below:

- Author (Year)
- Background
- Objective
- Methodology Optional
- Findings
- Conclusion

Then the students got an insight about the Sources of data which includes Primary data and Secondary data. The Primary data is also called as First-hand information that include data gathered trough face to face interactions, whereas the Secondary data is called as Second-hand information that consists of Journals, Articles, Websites, Periodicals, Reports etc.

Then the Resource person talked about the importance of Citation/ Reference in the Reference style-APA. The Resource person also asked the students to write the literature review based on the format that he gave earlier. There was also a discussion in regard to the Social Research and Social Work Research. Then the concept of variables in the research study was discussed. The Resource person explained the concept of variables with an example of Satisfaction level based on the teaching style.

The next topic of discussion was the objectives of the research study in which the general objectives and specific objectives have to be framed for a research topic and study. The Resource said to the students that the objectives of the research study shall start with 'To'. In order to frame the objectives, the Researcher can use words like 'To study', 'To find', 'To observe', 'To evaluate', 'To determine' etc.

The Field of study in the Research methodology was also discussed along with the Area of study. The Area of study is interdisciplinary fields of research and scholarship pertaining to particular geographical, national/federal, or cultural regions. Then the Statement of the problem was also discussed which speaks about the Facts, figures and statistics of the topic. The Need for Research study, Findings and Suggestions were also covered by the Resource person.

Next the Resource person also discussed with the students about the various types of research. It is indeed important to identify the type of Research in a research study. There are various types such as Quantitative and Qualitative. The Research design comprises of **Descriptive**, **Diagnostic**, **Experimental and Exploratory**. The Methods used in the Data collection are Interview, Case study, Surveys, Questionnaire, Focus Group discussion and observation and also added that the Interview can be done as an Interview Schedule and Interview guide. The students also learned about the Convergent parallel, Sequential Explanatory and Sequential Exploratory.

Then Dr. Godfrey explained about the types of sampling which comprises of Probability and Non- probability sampling. He first defined about probability sampling and its types. Probability Sampling consists of Simple Random, Systematic Random, Stratified Random and Cluster sampling etc. Non-probability sampling is defined as a sampling technique in which the researcher selects samples based on the subjective judgment of the researcher rather than random selection. The Resource person said that under non-probability sampling, all the units of the population do not get an equal chance of participating in the study. The Non-probability sampling includes Convenience, Purposive, Snowball and Quota sampling.

Then on the second day the Resource person discussed about the use of Research instruments in the Research study and also about the Findings and suggestions that have to be included in the Research study. The concept of Measures of Data which include **Nominal, Ordinal, Interval and Ratio** were clearly explained by Dr. Alan Godfrey.

The Resource person moved on to the use of SPSS software. SPSS means "Statistical Package for the Social Sciences" which is used for editing and analyzing all sorts of data. The resource person ensured that all the students have installed the SPSS software in their laptops. The Resource person taught the students how to export an Excel Spreadsheet in SPSS software. He also explained about the SPSS user interface, data view, variable view that is the data sheet and coding sheet. He then made a live demo using the SPSS software to interpret a specific set of data where he clearly explained the students how to choose scales, add entries of appropriate values & labels and to get the frequency statistics through the Analyze tab. Also Dr. Alan Godfrey provided a data on the board and instructed the students to analyze it using SPSS and generate the appropriate frequency statistical table of the data provided which was a good practice for the students.

Next the resource person explained to the students about **Zotero** software and its uses. He made a live demo using Zotero windows application and Zotero chrome connect extension to generate citations and references from online articles and journals. Finally he explained about tables and charts and making interpretations with it and clearly taught the students how to write the conclusion for a research study. The Workshop on Research Methodology ended by 4:00 PM on 20th January, 2023 with the Vote of Thanks by Sarveswaran. R T of 2nd Year MSW.

Outcome of the Programme:

The Research Methodology workshop was made meaningful with the Resource person being intriguing whereby he covered all the facets of the Research study topics. The students got an insightful thought on the Research Methodology and it will be indeed an eye-opening session for the students to carry out their Research in the coming days.

The Resource person gave an overview on all the important aspects of the Research study such as the Literature Reviews, Sampling techniques, Measurement tools etc. Apart from the Research Methodology, the Resource person also gave a deep insight about the Use of SPSS software in the Data analysis of the Research. The students were motivated to learn all the features of the SPSS software and it was indeed a knowledge enrichment session in the aspect of using SPSS software. This Research Methodology workshop has ensured that the students have got clarity on their Research topics and it ensures that the Research studies can be carried out with the utmost precision based on the key takeaways from this workshop.
