REPORT

He narrated the interesting story of three friends the first one without which living is impossible which means worldly material possession, second is one which is met with frequently which means family and friends and the third is very rarely associated with which means ones good deeds which goes with you even after your death. Furthermore, he stated that ethics is all





- > To preach and practice ethics in one's life.






12. Outcome of the Programme:


12. Outcome of the Programme:

DETAILED REPORT OF THE EVENT:

The session on Diversity, inclusion and equity in education commenced at 11:30 AM with a 'Thamizh Thaai vazhthu'. The master of ceremony was Ms. Samyugdha of 1st MSW, the gathering was welcomed by Mr. Suniel of 1st MSW and the guest introduction was given by Ms. Maheshwari of 1st MSW. The session started with an introduction of the guest herself that she had completed her MBA (HR) and currently working in the NGO - AID India. There were two questions for the students: 'who were the students from rural areas?' and 'why did all of you choose MSW?' There were around five to six responses for the first question and this question was asked as the session was related to rural education. For the next question, Reshma Nancy and Nalini replied that there was practical exposure in this field and lots of opportunities to learn about and with people, making this course unique. The next question for the students was to make this session more interactive: 'what were the words that come to their mind when they hear the term "school education?" There were lots of replies simultaneously from the students, and a few words were; hard work, teachers, exams, report card, rote learning, hours and hours of study, pass and fail, and so on.

Then directly the guest lecturer moved to the topic and stated that enrolment of students into education is not the current issue, as more than 99% of the students are enrolled in schools in Tamil Nadu but the quality of education and learning is the issue. There were statistics provided that;

- Only 40% of the students in 5th grade know to read Tamil, which could be read by 2nd-grade students
- Only 25% of the students in 5th grade know to read English, which could be read by 2nd-grade students
- Only 25% of the students in 5th grade know to solve simple mathematical problems, which could be solved by 2nd-grade students

It was also informed that few students in school by – heart the paragraph through images in that paragraph so that they could read that paragraph; due to this, the students are unable to read any sentence in the invitation or new paper or any other source. The quality of private schools in rural areas is found to be similar to that of government schools in rural areas due to which the complete education of the students is affected. Communication also gets affected because of this. The guest lecturer also mentioned that to practice the Tamil language there is an environment but to practice the English language there is a lack of an environment and in rural areas the situation is even worse. The lecturer added that parents are also a reason for the lack of quality education, especially in government schools.

The parents of government school children have no awareness that if the child is not studying properly the teachers can be questioned.



This organization also builds houses for the needy apart from providing education to the students.

The session came to an end by proposing the vote of thanks by Naveen Thomas. G of 1st MSW and then followed by National Anthem.



DETAILED REPORT:

The guest lecture on "Building dementia friendly community" began was scheduled on 3rd February 2023 at 2 PM for 1st MSW students. The resource person was Ms. Merita Joseph, Deputy Manager, Dignity Foundation, Chennai Chapter. To begin with the guest lecture, the resource person initially asked the students if they have any elderly at home. It was followed with the question, "How much time do they spend with the elderly at home?". It seemed like few students spend time with the elderly at home. The Dignity foundation was especially started for senior citizens where a few years ago, the founder of Dignity foundation met an old lady in an airport. The lady was lost and she didn't know the local language of that place. She was a native speaker of Hindi and the founder helped that lady by translating what she was trying to say to the airport authorities. It took a few days to trace the old lady's son. He left his mother in an airport far away from his house, so that she won't come back. That was the moment the founder realised that she has to work for the senior citizens.

This organisation worked for senior citizens with Dementia and it is a mental disorder that degenerates brain cells. It can't be cured; however, the increasing seriousness can be slowed down. Dementia stages can be prolonged up to four years. It may be caused due to high levels of stress, depression, severe injury and loneliness. Dementia can be commonly found in people above the age of 60 yet, nowadays many people face dementia as early as 50 years. Before COVID, there were only 36 patients in that organisation whereas currently there are 60 patients which portrayed that after COVID, the number of dementia patients has nearly doubled and that was due to lack of socializing. Dementia mostly affected upper-middle-class people as those people often stay indoors and don't socialize much so it automatically turned out to be a cause for dementia. Whereas the lower class people socialize easily with everyone and were aware of their neighbourhood. They also have lower stress levels compared to upper-middle-class people. Dementia weakens some of the cells and the undamaged cell's storage information will only be remembered which may lead to forgetting the family members.

There were three stages of dementia. They were

- Mild level
- Moderate and
- Severe level

In the mild stage, only minor differences could observe. For example: forgetting keys, files, driving skills. If it is figured out at this stage then the severity of dementia could be reduced. At a moderate level, communication would weaken. For example, a running fan was suddenly stopped and the patient wasn't able to ask to turn it on again. Instead, he said, something was coming and it suddenly stopped, what was it? This incident recently happened to a patient in the Dignity foundation. Dementia patients faced regular mood swings and they may shout and break things. For that reason, in a few families, the patients were locked in a room forcefully and that made them more aggressive. Most of the organisations which worked for dementia patients often would give high-dosage tablets to control them yet, this is not advisable for the health. Engaging them in activities can be an alternative to that. When they draw, colour, sing, dance, etc, their mind would be distracted and their focus would be on that activity. The last stage is the severe stage. At this stage, dementia patients would become bedridden. The caretakers in India aren't trained and it's considered a low-paid job.

Then a video was showcased to the students by the resource person. The video was about an old lady who was living in a house with her son, daughter-in-law and granddaughter. She forgot to plug in the cooker to cook, wrongly buttoning her shirt and it got more severe. Once she went out to buy food for her granddaughter and she forgot her way back home. She asked random strangers on the road to help her go home, but she didn't remember the address or any details. Her son and daughter-in-law found her on the road. She couldn't recognise them and she asked them to help her go home. Then her granddaughter arrived surprisingly the old lady remembered her granddaughter. She hugged her and cried. That may be due to the stronger bond she holds with her granddaughter.

In dignity foundation, a patient was taken to his home in the car. Suddenly he told to stop the car and said that his house was in that area. That's the area in which the patient lived in his childhood. That place was close to his heart so he remembered that place. There was an activity done by the 1st MSW students. The students were divided into groups and each group has to come up with ideas for creating dementia friendly environment. Each group consisted of approximately five members. Ten minutes were given to the students to develop interesting ideas and some of the noticeable points they came up with were;

- To conduct awareness programs on dementia
- To encourage families to accept them
- To train the caretakers of dementia patients
- Being patient with affected patients
- To ask the patients to narrate their old stories
- To remind them about their achievements
- To spend time with dementia patients

The Dignity foundation has planned to celebrate its silver jubilee celebration for the Chennai branch on 25th February 2023. Intergeneration sports activity has been planned to be conducted at Patrician college. Games such as slow walking and caroms would be conducted between an older generation person and a younger generation person. This would be open to all and anyone could join that event. Followed by that, on March 18th, a talent show was planned to be conducted for the elderly in Balaji mahal. Talents such as storytelling, dancing, and singing shall be showcased. The main celebration would be conducted in July or August at Stella Maris college. A dance show would be performed for all and the prizes for those competitions would be distributed. The guest lecture came to an end by proposing the vote of thanks by Mr. Sudhakar. V.




OUTCOME:

Feedback was sent to the students at the end of the session. A total of 41 students attended the workshop and they have all filled in the feedback the results are as follows








Inauguration - 21, Feb, 2023

After a formula welcome, Dr.V.Renganayaki, Joint Coordinator of this workshop threw light on Bharatiya Bhasha Samiti and its objectives.

Dr.Uthra, Coordinator addressed the audience about the need for such a workshop, its key objectives and gave an outline on the rationale behind each of the technical sessions.

Principal, Dr.Santhosh Baboo felicitated the chief guest and spoke about the importance of learning in mother tongue. He reinforced the need to bring out textbooks in different languages along with books for the general public, to understand our country's growth in S&T.

In the captivating **inaugural address** by Dr Sudha Seshayyan, Former Vice-Chancellor, The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai, she beautifully narrated how ancient Tamils integrated Science with their life, citing examples from Sangam period. Very casually they were able to couple knowledge, what is

Scientia , essentially Science in their verses. Centuries before Pascal, in Moothurai (IDIDIDID) verse, Ouvaiyar says how ever one applies force, no container (IDIDIDID) can hold more than its capacity. This shows their deep understanding and practical ability, which we should learn to appreciate. At the sametime, with times evolving, there is a need to expand scientific vocabulary in every language. She quoted how important it is to use Scientific words very precisely based on the context. Especially being a medical practitioner, every word they use to document a patient's medical records are very crucial for the individual and families. This caught the attention of every participant and they could relate with the importance of scientific terminologies. She insisted on the need for a transdisciplinary approach for science communication in regional languages.

This was followed by the release of four books on Science/ Education in Tamil for the public, written by the teachers of the Physics Department.

These were received by Dr.C.Vijayan, Prof. of Physics, IITM and Mr.Dorairajan. Also commemorating the National Science day that was nearing, a portraitof Sir.CV Raman was unveiled. This was made from wires and resistors and other electronic components by the students, integrating STEM with Art.

Technical sessions

Session 1: *Science Communication in Regional Languages* by Dr C Vijayan, Dept. of Physics, IIT Madras, Chennai

He insisted how learning in mother tongue enhances absorbing, retaining information and helps in processing it faster. Efficient learning is possible for many, but effective learning is possible only through mother tongue in formative ages mainly. To understand concepts deeply and to enhance problem solving skills, we need books in regional languages that help higher order thinking skills. Students could connect with this idea and how they can improve this skill. He shared his experience and the need for writing a book "Velicham" on concepts of light in Malayalam to help school and college students assimilate these concepts better.

Session 2: *Tamil Science Fiction-Significance*, *opportunities & Challenges* by Shri. Sudhakar Kasturi, Tamil Writer

This session took the audience on a trail where they lost and found themselves, waking up to the fact that along with language skills, one needs solid foundation on Science concepts/facts before envisaging to scifi writing. Students were moved when they learnt about our country's greatest science communicator Prof. Yashpal's ideas about geostationary orbit. Interaction with the speaker gave them a good hold on what one takes to become a writer in current scenario.

Session 3: Creating stories from events, Mr. J.Chandramouli, Journalist

Mainly focussed on creating storyboards out of real events, through an National

Innovation foundation prize winner's story. How this innovation easing roadside *ironwallah's* drudgery throughsolar power.

Session 4: *Meet Tamil writers*, Shri. V.V.Balasubramanian, Vivekananda Kendra

This session literally helped every participant to connect with people/tribals living remote corners of our great Bharath. Being in publication division and in youth empowerment, the speaker captivated every participant, describing to them the yeomen service done by kendra in islands of Andamans or interiors of Bihar or hilly regions of Assam. Participants had a lot of questions for him on how they too can volunteer. This helped them to realise why we need to contribute towards their growth, empathise, and how they can contribute in Bharatiya bhashas to connect with them.

Session 5: a. *Muthamizh Arignar Project & CSIR* @ 80, Dr. V. Renganayaki

This session was designed to help students to explore various projects of our Government to poularise science and TN government's Muthamizh Aringnar project creating and translating science books for students. She helped every participant translate posters from CSIR@80and CSIR SVASTIK to Tamil, a new experience and a new skill they learnt here.

b. *Science Journalism*, Thiru.M.Murugesh gave a glimpse on publication divisions, how to hone one's skill as a journalist. This was a hit with students where for most of them meeting a senior journalist was a dream come true. He asked them to delve deep into any subject they choose.

Session 6: From Moonrise to Masala Dosai by Rangarathnam Gopu

From beginning to end, this session questioned what we have read from textbooks, and what we have missed to learn from IKS. How marvelous and well developed was our technology much before the West! Even in the 9th Century, a simple well design in a remote village speaks volumes about the geometry knowledge, engineering prowess we had. This season opened everyone's eyes to why we need to understand our Bhartiya system, take it to the masses with the correct rationale, and why we need such workshops to take these in the Bharatiya perspective.

Session 7: a. *DST Vigyan Prasar Initiatives popularising Science*, Dr.Lenin Tamilkovan

b. Ariviyal Palagai, DST initiative in Tamil, Mr.Srikumar Balakrishnan

Vigyan Prasar under DST, Govt. of India has publications, periodicals, kits in many

languages. IndiaScience channel helps students to learn about different R&D labs, institutions and innovations. Ariviyal Palagai is an initiative in Tamil, which takes science to the public through youtube videos, interviews and write ups. Participants were amazed to know such initiatives.

Session 8: *Science Journalism*, Dr.Ku Vai Balasubramanian

His anecdotes from Tamil literature on meteorological facts, made students throw a lot of questions eliciting answers. He clearly emphasized why and how significant it is to understand the causes, difference and connection between rain, downpour, floods, cyclones, tornedos. Especially in this whatsapp age, where more misinformation is spread, it is necessary such workshops provide young minds to understand the facts and help the public filter correct information.

Session 9: *Popular Science writing*, Mr. Sivaraman Halasyan

This session gave an overview on many participant's questions - how to choose content for youtube or insta reels in science. He practically handled their curiosity and wanted them to get updated with news and current happenings. This comes with disciplined work and regular reading habits.

4. Conclusion of the Programme

In this workshop, from inaugural address till valedictory, participants were actively engaged, were guided to think about communication in regional languages. They got a glimpse of how Bharatiya bhashas are connected many times, though we are not aware of it in our daily chores. The necessity to grow our communication skills and building our vocabulary would help us to become a strong nation as such. Enriching our own mother tongue or language we speak in our region as S&T grows, various ways for these were discussed. Usage of words, translating them appropriate to the context kindled everyone's mind. Interacting with media professionals opened up a new area on jobopportunities for most of the student participants. They understood the need to integrate S&T to mainstream media and definitely there is a need for science journalists in every media house.

Participants learnt to translate articles, dub videos. They could learn the nuances in writing Sci Fi forthe Indian audience, especially in our own languages. They were excited to learn about opportunitiesgalore as sci fi writers, do science documentaries, write content for museums/zoos/science centers. When they learnt about technology used by our Bharitiyas, which we have forgotten now, every one of them felt the urge to learn more and pass this knowledge to others around. Contributions of Brahmagupta, Varahmihira, our ancient chemists, astronomers came alive which the textbooks do nottalk about.

Current initiatives of our government to take S&T in different languages across our country enthused them and reinforced their faith in the progress of our nation when we put our heart and soul towardsit.

5. Outcomes of the Programme

- 1. *houses, while they*This trans-disciplinary workshop could bind students from humanities to aScience Department, in the way shown by STIP 2020.
- 2. Able to help participants understand S&T initiatives of our government like VIGYAN PRASAR, INDIA SCIENCE, CSIR @ 80, CSIR-NISCAIR to take Science and Technology to students and common man.
- 3. Students and other participants could learn about Ariviyal Palagai, a DST Vigyan Prasar initiative in TAMIL
- 4. Participants could interact with Tamil journalists, bloggers and Tamil Science writers, some of them freelancers, some are journalists. By interacting with them, they got an overview of opportunities available in the field of journalism or media to report Science based activities in Bharatiya Bhashas, with more focus on Tamil. And most importantly, how to search for facts, improvise their content and build vocabulary based on the context.
- 5. Get a glimpse of Science communication in Tamil Print media and electronic media Challenges and Support system in place. *Finally, journalism students felt that they were yet to meet science journalists in media who have met specially dedicated sports journalists, finance analysts or political journalists.* This perception itself is a success of the workshop.
- 6. Could make them understand the necessity for creating new words, and being gendersensitive, age-appropriate, context appropriate and being sensitive towards marginalised communities while creating words
- 7. Participants could do dubbing Science videos for media, a step towards reaching public, builda skill
- 8. Participants felt My culture, My pride, My duty by Translating texts in Bharatiya bhashas, here in Tamil of CSIR280 and NISCPR SWASTIK- translations by participants attached along with this file
- 9. Three participants who were **visually challenged also got benefitted**, which made us feel this workshop is inclusive in different ways.
- 10. Pre -workshop questionnaire and assessing Learning outcomes for every technical session was designed to intellectually stimulate the participants. This itself can be used as learning material for many other workshops. These are attached

11. Recommendations

- 1. Knowledge transfer in Bharatiya Bhashas is possible, but a sustained effort is needed along with a support system, as given by BBS now.
- 2. Need a network of those who work in transfer of knowledge
- 3. We can think of comics in different languages (Ayushman comics done by Ministry of Ayush)
- 4. Journalists should be empowered to speak about science better
- 5. Citizens, students, parents need access to materials in different languages- both digital and hard bound. Example, Vigyan Prasar materials, CSIR @80, SVASTIK materials to be made more popular in all languages. Need more citizen science movements.
- 6. Tradition, history, art, culture, food connect every citizen of Bharath. If new generation has to realise this, we need to integrate these into our academics in a sustainable manner
- 7. Bringing in dance forms of various tribals/ states speaking different bhashas but based on our own culture can be used to convey this message.
- 8. We can think of bringing out the biography of Bharatiya scientists (which are already documented by DST) with help of IITS/IISERS funding or their SSR activity. Each of them can cover each language specific to their area too.
- 9. Such booklets in different bhashas would help schools to perform them as drama/ dance dramas/ skits in different languages. This way, young minds will understand the greatness of our *bhumi*.
- 10. Kollu or navarathri dolls of Scientists like Acharya PC Ray, Acharya Bose, Sir CV Raman, Srinivasa Ramanujam, Janaki Ammal and many more made by different artisans of our country is a need to spread just Science, but the feeling of oneness.

- 11. While creating banners, content we felt the need for BHARATIYA faces/ characters in googleimages are missing in pixabay, insta...anywhere. There is a need now.
- 12. A single museum where a collection of instruments used by Bharatiya scientists from 1880-1940 of our country could take Science communication farther and further.
- 13. Every existing Science centre/ Museums in every state can have multiple language audio facilities in Bharatiya bhashas. Say, if one visits a museum in Jaipur, they should be able to learn about our country in Tamil or Telugu too.
- 14. Archives in different IITS, IISERS can help us unite through S&T, history of Scientists, innovations, instead of citizens being just consumers of Technology. This would help peoplein different regions speaking different languages believe in the growth of our country as a single mission.
- 15. Science communication needs a big funding, thrust, significance if it has to make its impact in our country. TV channels and print media, airport book shops, Museums, archives, academia, R&D all of us need to work in sync to achieve this in Bharatiya bhasas. It is possible with more limelight and support.







9. OUTCOME OF THE EVENT:


