An Initiative of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) as College Component of e-ShodhSindhu Consortium. Provided extended access to selected e-resources to colleges covered under Section 12B of UGC Act as well as Non-aided colleges from 2010 to 2013.

The N-LIST programme under E-ShodhSindhu operates through its Headquarters set-up at the INFLIBNET CENTRE, Gandhinagar, Gujarat, India.



Elephants in the Room

We would argue that the largely fruitless efforts which have characterized the vast majority of extant CSR research to date are particularly unfortunate given the major shifts in economy, politics, society and culture which have occurred since the field's inception. Our position is that these shifts, potentially epochal in their impact, will largely structure future organizational fields within which corporations must operate; that corporate actors are not only passive reactors to these developments, but also in many instances *active shapers* of market, industry and sector evolution operating at various geographical levels; and that, by and large, these developments have not been explored by CSR scholarship.
