## **Departmental Activities 2022-23**

## September 2023

## • Student Induction Programme – 09/09/2022

The SIP was conducted for the batch of 2022-24. Resource persons from across the industry were invited to deliver lectures for students as they were young minds venturing into the industry.

### • Power Talk – 15/09/2022

The students of II MA HRM attended a session organised by NHRD, ISTD, NIPM on trends in HRM over the last 5 decades. The resource person was Prof. Dr. T. V. Rao has vast experience in teaching HRM over the decades. He covered the HRD trends over the last 5 decades in India and the students found the session to be very useful.

## • One Day workshop on SPSS – 12/10/2022

The speaker began the session with an introduction to statistics and gave an overview of statistical tests, as well as the application of the SPSS software. He highlighted that SPSS

is a collection of software packages that can be used to examine scientific data related to social science. He also discussed the different types of data in statistics and then moved on to talk about the various methods used to study variation. Overall, the session provided valuable insights into statistics and its applications.

### • Workshop on Excel – 13/10/2022

The students of I MA HRM attended a 1 day workshop on MS Excel with Mr. Venkatraman Subramaniam as the resource person. The initial session focused on the use of Microsoft Excel for data management and analysis.
