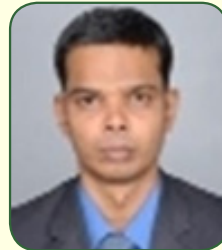

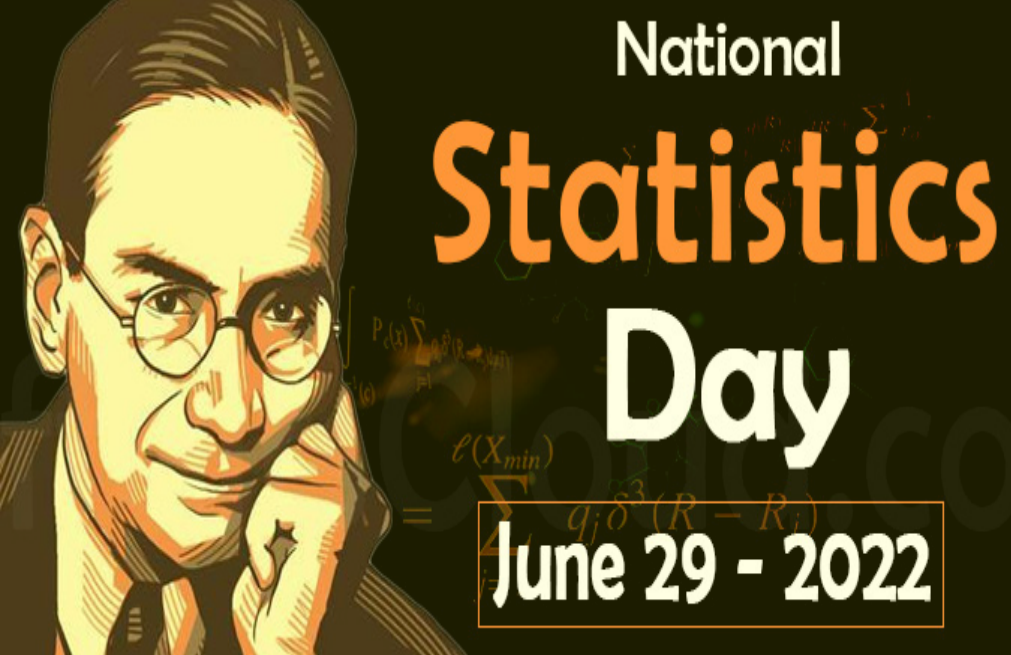

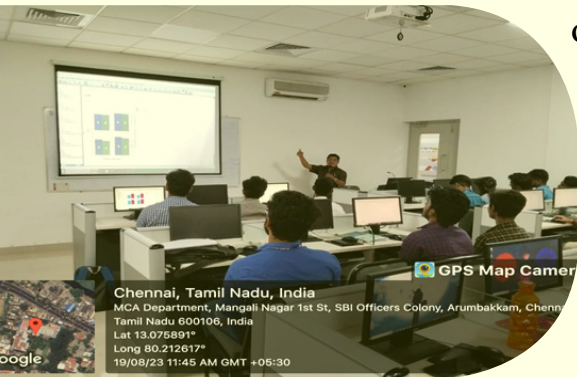


Bizstat Association Investiture Ceremony was conducted by Department of Statistics on 20/07/2023

Guest Lecture and BIZSTAT Association Investiture Ceremony on 20-07-2024

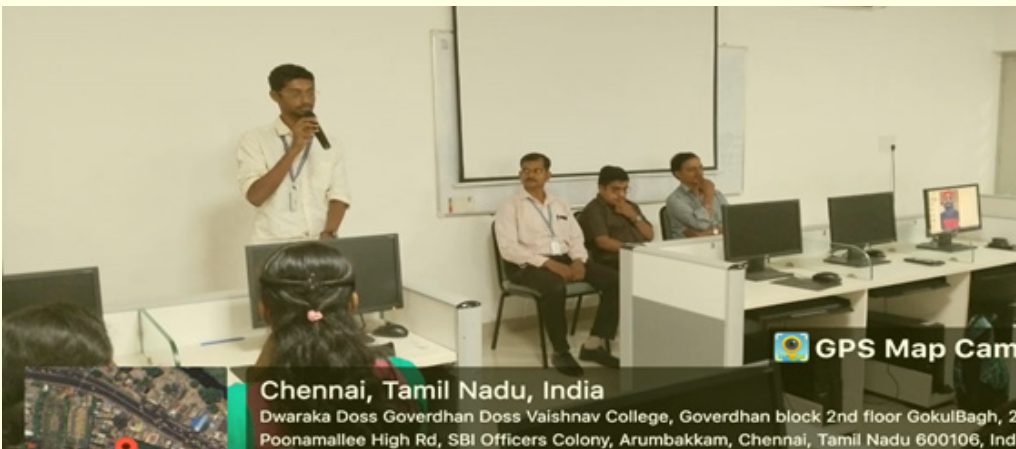

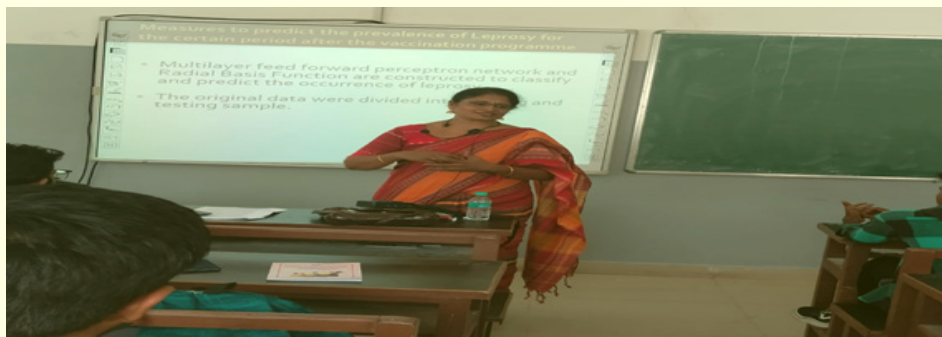
