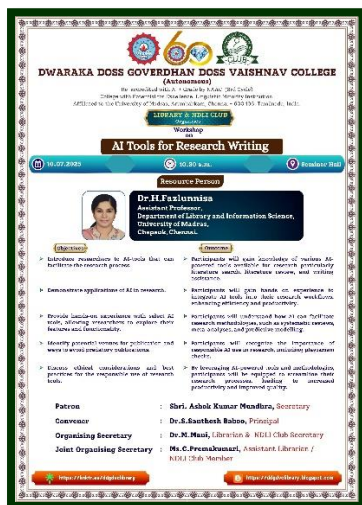

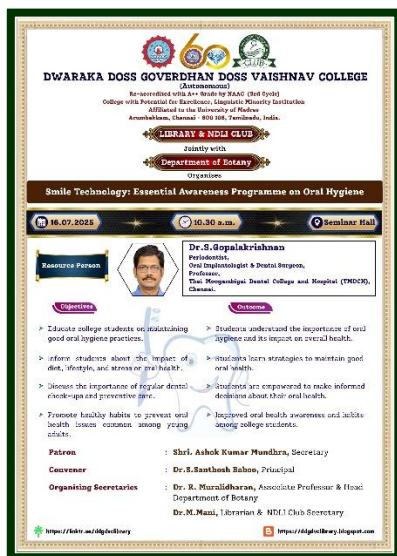
The retiring staff Mr.S.Nesarathinam, Assistant, DDGDVC was honoured for his relentless service and dedication towards the institution.

## Imagine & Inspire: Storytelling Contest 2026 on 11.02.2026



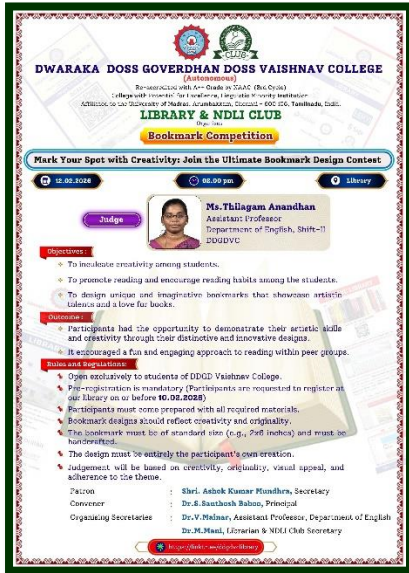
### Report:

## Bookmark Competition on 12.02.2026



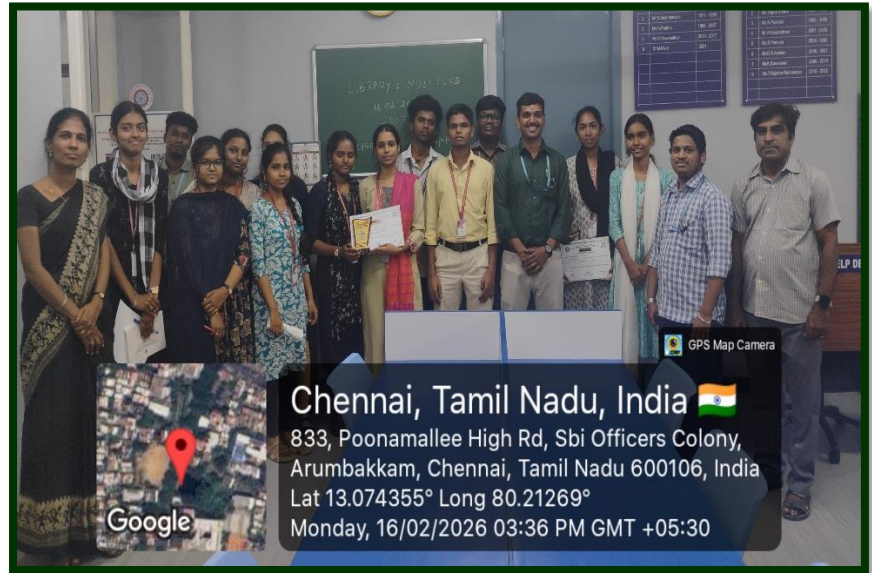
### Report:
