### Office of the Controller of Examinations

#### Vision

• To be conscious of and work towards *Quality*; a defining element in the qualitative expansion of contemporary Indian higher education.

#### Mission

- To work with the realization that Higher Education Institutions (HEI's), are "the most direct agents of change and advocates of improvement."
- To "redefine and reinvent college curriculum, pedagogy, and assessment policies" and ensure all students acquire 21<sup>th</sup> century knowledge skills, attributes and competencies.
- To set high standards in higher education as per the guiding principles of the *UGC Quality Mandate* 2018 and the *New Education Policy* 2020.

The Office of the Controller of Examinations was set up in accordance with the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Institutions, on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2009, after the institution was declared 'Autonomous.' The institution is also affiliated to the University of Madras and adheres to the norms prescribed by its affiliating University especially in matters relating to minimum course requirements leading to undergraduate, postgraduate, M.Phil and Ph.D programmes, Choice based Credit System, (CBCS), the computation of Grade Point Average, (GPA), Cumulative Grade Point Average, (CGPA), and the ten-point Grading scale. The CBCS was adopted in 2009, since autonomy. The degree leading towards the completion of a program is however awarded by the University of Madras.

The 'autonomous' status permits the institution a considerable degree of flexibility in enriching and modernizing the curriculum and syllabus, pedagogical tools and techniques, breaking the tight boundaries between disciplines, introduction of add- on courses, increasing the number of Generic and Discipline Specific Electives, and most importantly, evaluation reforms. Decisions taken by the department in terms of new courses, revising or reframing existing courses, add-on courses, MOOC courses, credits and credit transfers and the methodology of evaluation have to be approved by the Board of Studies (BOS), and the Academic Council (AC), which have been constituted as per UGC stipulations and are conducted annually. Autonomy has allowed the institution and in turn the Examinations Office to rethink and reframe the pattern and testing methodology, set rubrics, introduce qualitative measures and to raise the overall standards to empower the student community to face the 21<sup>st</sup> century challenges.

The Examinations Office comprises five sections each having specific objectives and duties. And currently employs 20 staff members besides three faculty members who are the office bearers. However, the concerted efforts of all five sections are invariably required for the conduct of Examinations, Valuation and the publication of results. The office is housed in the second and third floors of the Main Administrative building.

- **1.Academic & Confidential section**: All Department regulations are filed and maintained in this section. List of subjects along with subject codes are compiled three months prior to the examinations. Communication is sent to the External Examiners much in advance for Question paper setting. Examination time table is also finalized by this section besides organizing the Board of Studies and Academic Council meetings.
- 2. Records Maintenance & Verification section: Hard copies of student academic records are maintained by this section staff who manually enter the list of subjects of each student. These records are hard bound registers and the archives are stored in the basement. The office maintains student records since 2009. The section staff physically verify student data based on the records. The team also coordinates the Central Valuation camp and the Results Passing Board.
- 3. Software Programming &Data Entry section: The section staff maintain soft copies of student data, right from entry level until completion of the course and the Permanent Pass Register, (PPR), is sent to the University of Madras. This section has to work along with an external partnering software agency, (outsourced since 2012), for all software applications and automation.
- 4. **Finance section**: Honorarium and remuneration for all academic activities and examination-related services are handled by this section. They coordinate the Finance Committee and the Annual Graduation Day.
- 5. Student Grievance & Enquiry section: Current and prior batch students submit their requests/applications/queries at Counter 7, in the ground floor, Main Administrative building. During the pandemic and lockdown, requests were forwarded via email. The staff at the counter files the requests and coordinates with the respective sections to address and resolve issues.

#### **ACADEMIC INITIATIVES:**

Outcome based Education (OBE) and Bloom's Taxonomy implemented in the academic year 2020-2021, based on UGC Academic Reforms in Higher Education Institutions (HEI)'s.

Outcome based Education implemented for the 2020 UG/PG batch and all departments framed their Programme Outcomes and Course Outcomes in tandem with the Institutional Outcomes and the same were approved in the respective Board of Studies meetings. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell, (IQAC), organized orientation programmes for faculty members to measure the PO's /CO's. From AY 2021 onwards, all Internal evaluation and the End Semester Examinations will be structured around the attainment of the PO/CO. Uniform Question paper pattern will be followed for both Internal tests as well as the term end semester examinations from 2021 onwards; the same will be ratified and approved in the forthcoming 13<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council.

Spady and Marshall (1991) defines OBE as the means of focusing and organizing everything in an educational institute that is essential for students to perform successfully at the end of their learning experience (159). University Grants Commission (UGC) set the objectives of quality mandate for improving thequality of Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) in India. Serious rethinking was given to Examination Reforms as the prevalent examination system did not focus on broader skills or deeper learning based on cognitive abilities. Annual or semester examinations was a limited assessment only. The end-of-term examinations, in many cases, are for three hours each and that is the sole tool to decide the future career of students and the question papers tests only memory recall as a skill. There is very little focus on continuous assessment during the teaching/ learning / process.

The OBE approach helps to focus on the utilization of appropriate instruction and pedagogy; organize teaching and learning processes around career advancement and placement of students; select and design appropriate assessment modes; and ensure that programmes are awarded based ondemonstrated achievement of outcomes. The core philosophy of Learning Outcome Based Education (LOBE) rests in adhering to the student-centric learning approach used to measure students' performance based on a pre-determined set of outcomes.

Resources, processes, curriculum, facilities, activities (both curricular and co-curricular), etc., need to be aligned to the expected outcomes, for which, clarity of what 'outcome' is, is a requisite. Outcomes are viewed as learning results that students are expected to demonstrate during or at the end of the educational experience. In the words of Killen (2000), some outcomes are expected to be demonstrated at the course level, some at the programme level, and others at the institution level.
