work trainees went to Dharmathupatti to mobilize people for the Dental Camp scheduled on 13.04.22.






DAY 03 - 13.04.2022



The programme was a grand success, the department plans to organize similar outreach programmes in near future. The school management gave us a huge support in conducting this programme.


