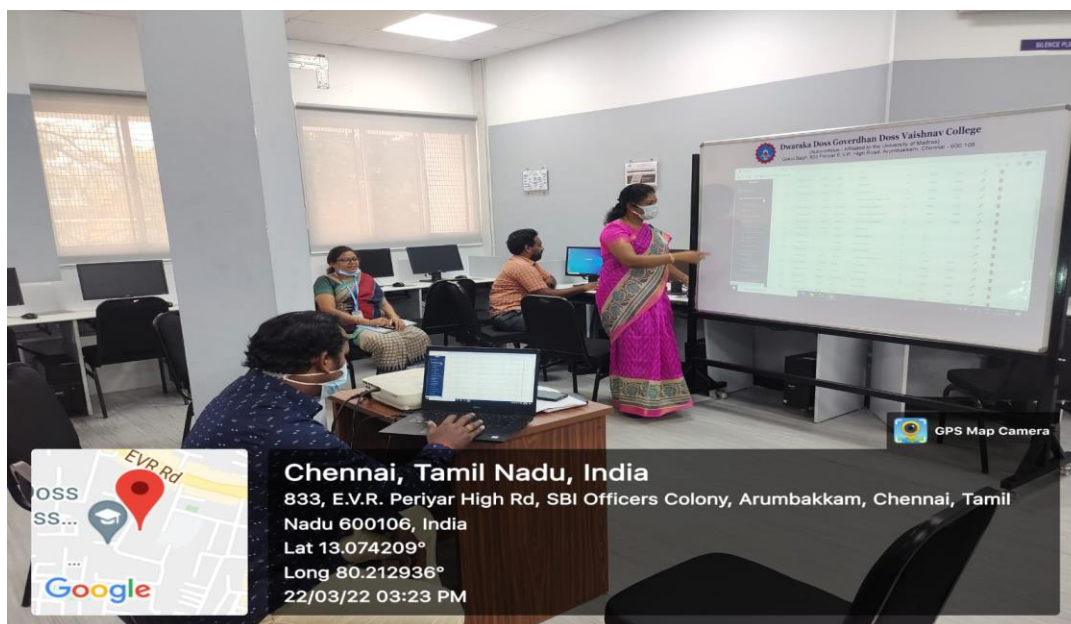

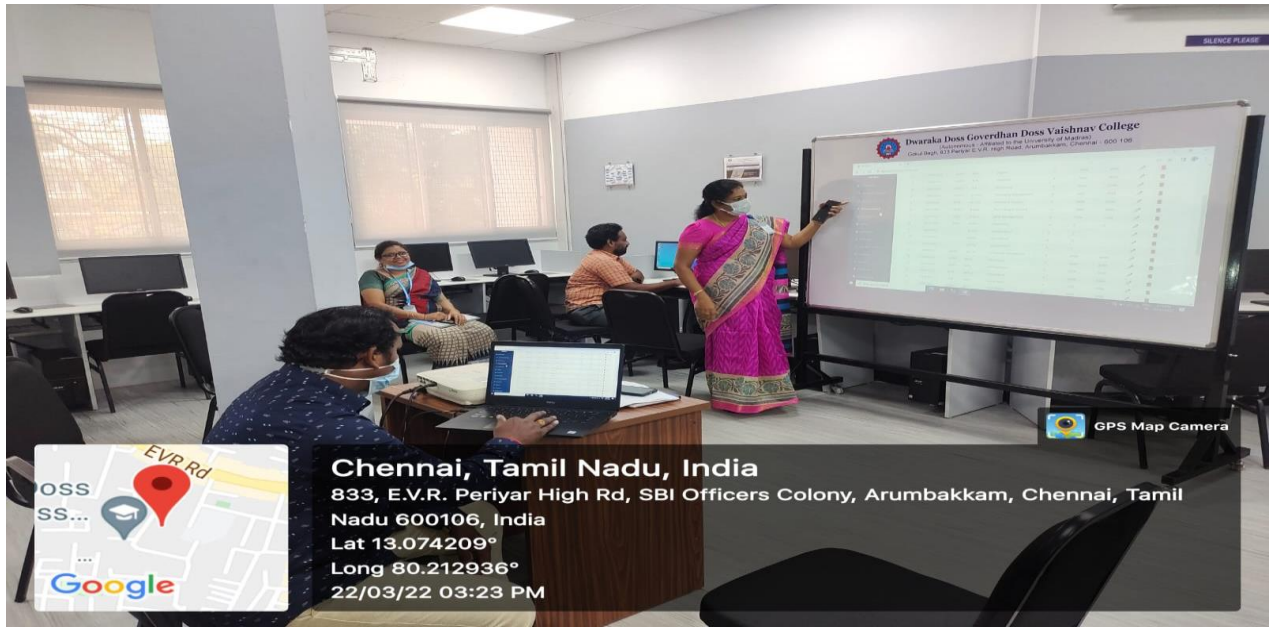

Outcome of the event:

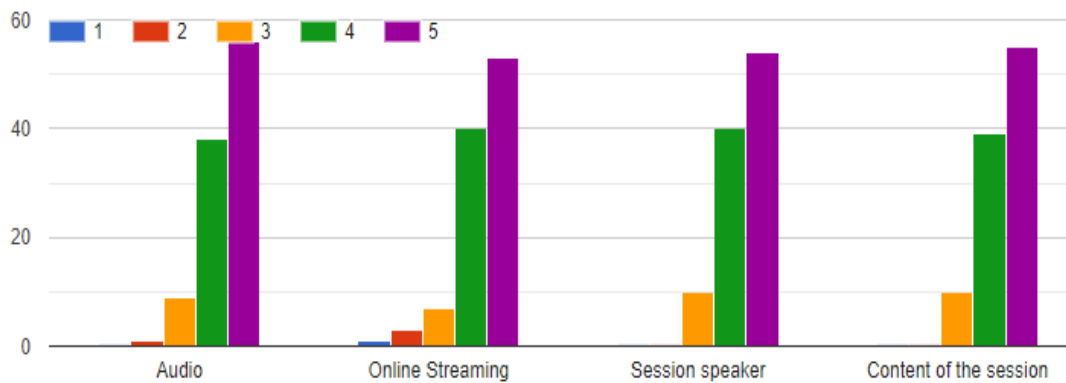
Participants were explained on the attainment of CO (course outcome) which was briefly as follows:-

The process of attainment of COs, POs and PSOs starts from finalizing COs for each course of the program from first year to final year. The course outcomes are discussed by the concerned faculty members and COs are finalized using action verbs of learning levels as per Bloom's Taxonomy. A correlation is established between COs and POs in the scale of 1 to 3, 1 being low, 2 being medium, 3 being high. A mapping matrix is prepared for every course in the program. Correlation between the COs and the program outcome (POs) and Program Specific Outcomes (PSOs) is established for all courses of the program.

For each course, attainment level of all COs is arrived based on the students performance in the internal and external examinations and through the direct and indirect assessment at the end of course.

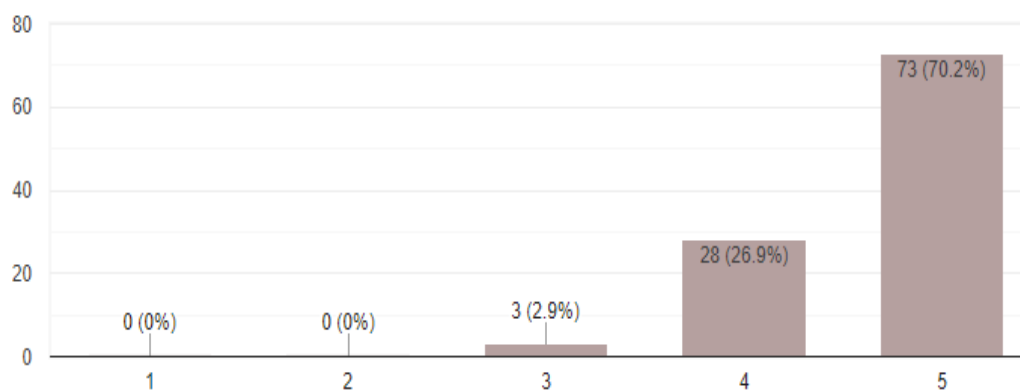

Report of the Programme:

“**Vaishnav Samastha Unnayanam**” – A 360 Degree Holistic Orientation of DDGDVC was conducted for one week in online mode from 28.09.2021 to 4.10.2021 by IQAC for the newly recruited faculty members of our institution during the beginning of the academic years 2020 and 2021.

The one week online FIP was inaugurated on 28.9.21 by **Professor William Dharma Raja**, Head, Department of Education, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University. The chief guest praised the institution for conducting an induction programme to orient the faculty into the nuances of the college in particular and the HEI in general. He urged the faculty to focus on three key areas namely Teaching, Research and Extension. He wanted the faculty to consider every week as a unit, fuse verbal and non-verbal cues into their teaching methodology and look for tangible differences in their profession from year to year.

Dr. T.S.Prema, Associate Professor & Head, PG & Research Department of Economics handled the second session on Day I on the topic – “NAAC & IQAC – Journey towards Excellence” in HEI. She highlighted in detail the journey of the HEI towards achieving NAAC Accreditation with respect to the 7 criterions. She stressed the importance of documenting the activities of the department in the manner prescribed by NAAC.

On Day 2 Session 1, **Dr Jayasankar**, Associate Professor & Head, PG & Research Department of Commerce spoke on “Grooming & Self Branding - The qualities and Values of a DDGD Vaishnav Faculty”. He expressed the need to adapt to the times in the wake of the pandemic. He stressed on the need of the faculty to impress the students through thoroughness of content, discipline and innovation. In Session 2, **Ms Jayalakshmi**, Associate Professor, Department of English spoke on how a Faculty become a Facilitator. She stated that extensive knowledge, effective listening and good interpersonal skills are the qualities of a facilitator to help students Think – Create and Innovate.

On Day 3 Session 1, **Dr. Augustine Arul Prasad**, Asst. Professor, PG & Research Department of Chemistry, highlighted the faculty on “Blended Learning – Order of the Day”. He explained the relevance of blended learning through practical live online teaching tools and highlighted the need to train students for jobs that do not exist today. In Session 2 on Day 3, **Dr. D. Uthra**, Associate Professor & Head, Department of Physics, spoke on the relevance of understanding the varied learning needs of students. She highlighted that teaching should be student centered and work towards exemptions and accommodations.

Ms Sangeetha from SCARF, Chennai spoke on stress management on Day 4 Session 1. She spoke on the causes of stress, signs of stress and methods to cope with stress. In Session 2, **Dr. R. Venkataraman**, Associate Professor & Head, Department of Mathematics, spoke on “Proactive

Faculty – The need of the hour”. He stressed the need to foresee the future and tackle the situation in advance. He cited examples of all the proactive activities done by the department.

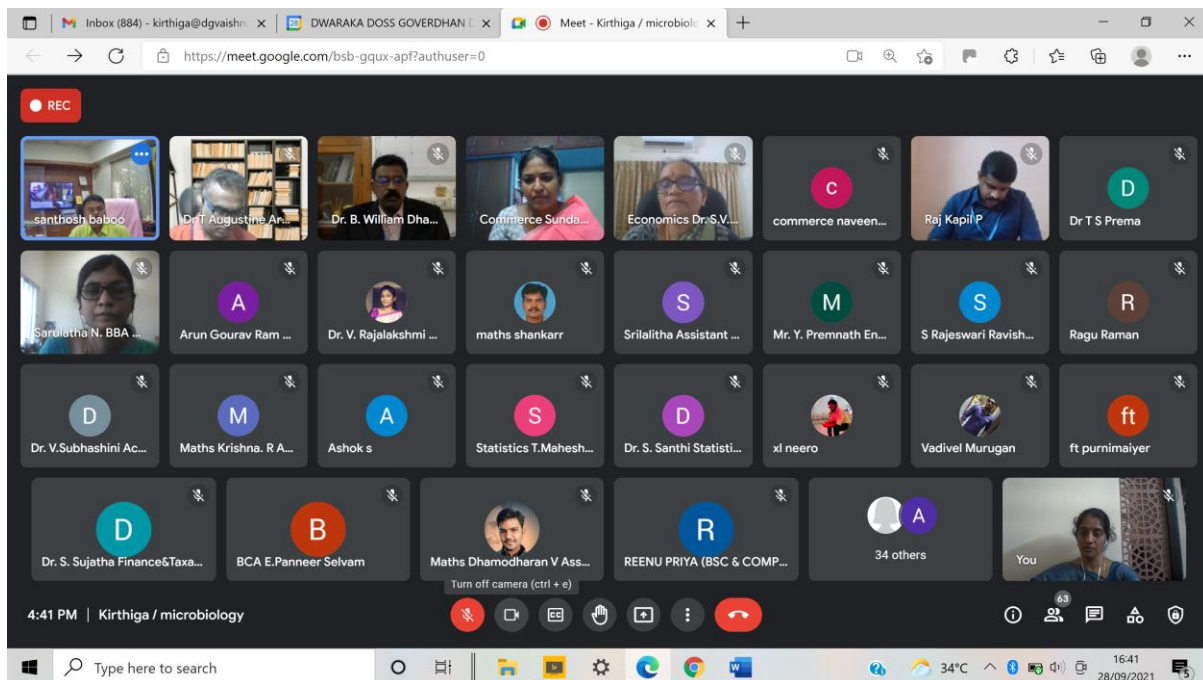

10. Detailed Report of the Programme

The Department of Physics and Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Dwaraka Doss Goverdhan Doss Vaishnav College organised a National level online faculty development programme in Science pedagogy in association with Indian Association of Physics teachers, (RC 13) during 9-16, August 2021. The objectives of the FDP were to

empower the faculty members with innovative pedagogy techniques for their professional development and students and enhanced learning; to inculcate and enhance the abilities of the faculty members to carry out independent research, write successful research projects etc. Also the aim of the FDP included familiarity with the usage of technological tools and simulation methodologies.

The faculty development program started on 9th August 2021 with the inaugural address by Dr Santosh Baboo, the Principal of the college. Dr T S Natarajan, Professor of Physics, IIT Tirupati delivered a talk on **the significance of experiential learning in Physics**. He stressed upon learning by doing and the experiments he shared with teacher participants was amazing. He threw light upon advanced experiential methods in the teaching -learning process.

The second day of the FDP had the session of Dr.O. S.K.S.Sastri, Professor of Physics Central University of Himachal Pradesh. His topic was **simulation methodology: a step-by-step approach to pedagogy of computer simulation Labs**. He threw light upon how to apply computer simulation techniques to solve quantum mechanical problems. His talk has motivated many young teacher participants to pursue research in the field of modelling, prediction, combining theoretical physics and computer simulations. GNUmeric software and its implementation opened up new vistas in simulation software techniques for young teacher participants. It made us feel how much we need to update with technology, learn coding and evolve with time to be a good teacher and researcher.

The third day we had an incredibly thought-provoking and inspiring presentation from Dr D Uthra, Associate professor and Head, department of Physics Dwaraka Doss Goverdhan Doss Vaishnav College. In her session titled **Differentiated classroom for STEM teachers**, She highlighted various pedagogical approaches and taught young teachers how to use them in their classes. It was so informative and the various implementation methods she threw light upon were useful to the participants. Creating a learning environment for students as per new education policy, conducting student induction programs, different assessment methodologies of students based on their skills and differentiated instructions all these she suggested would definitely help all the participants.

On 12/08/2021, Dr.Anupma Harshal, Consultant, Science Communication and public engagement, IISER Pune shared her experience & expertise that she had gathered in her journey as a researcher, teacher, and consultant. Her explanation of steps in the research process and types of research in her talk, **The art of story telling** was informative. As she said, the intellectual joy of doing some creative work is what motivates us to take another step. The dimensions of a good project proposal, the various sections in a project proposal, steps involved in applying a project & refining the proposal like a reviewer, all these she explained had shown the participants a different dimension.

Shri. Anoop Jaiswal was the speaker on the fifth day of the FDP. The knowledge he shared under the topic **SCIENCE T PLAY** will help and develop the teaching sector. The concepts of physics he demonstrated were with such simple household materials and it was really fascinating. All the young teacher participants would implement these in their teaching. Starting from the rocket toy, Benham's disc, toys to explain air pressure, Tyndall effect, all the demonstrations he performed were really useful to the participants. Using the simple toy he showed the whole gyroscopic principle, precession, nutation etc. It was really an awesome experience.

It was a wonderful presentation on **Research Based Pedagogical tools, what are they and why do we care ?** on the sixth day of the FDP. The resource person was Dr. Apurva Barve, Coordinator, CoSME, IISER Pune. The 5R's Recognise, Require, Refine, Report and Reward: the systematic approach of how to prepare a RBPT so that students get equipped with research skills; all these she explained in that session would definitely help teacher participants to implement these in their teaching - learning process.

The concluding session of the FDP was **The adventures of Science teaching** by Dr. C. Vijayan, Professor of Physics, IIT Madras on 16/08/2021. His depth of explanation about innovation and creative thinking has flooded the participants' mind with thoughts from different dimensions. The way he explained about inertia and its comparison with life was awesome. His talk was mind-blowing, full of

puzzles, tricks and it was so enjoyable for every participants. His years of research, depth of understanding the subject interfaces, and his ability to present it in such an interesting way produced one of the most memorable afternoons. Helping us think differently and adopt lateral thinking - wherever we are, we are sure, we will always try this out. Every teacher participant and student participant would definitely learn more about TOTO CHAN and learn more about Feynmans ways of teaching.

The Convenor of the FDP thanks IAPT RC-13 for giving support, suggestions and for helping them reach teachers from all over the country and collaborating with them to spread knowledge. Around 300 teacher participants from Colleges, residential schools across the country handling subjects such as Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Biochemistry, Microbiology, Mathematics etc. participated in the live sessions of FDP in YOU TUBE. The participants were assessed by online tests and were awarded certificates.
