




Rainwater drainage Facility near Admin Block








Rain Water Harvesting pit inside MBA Block

2. Borewell /Open Well Recharge

## Borewell/Open borewell recharge

This institution does not buy water from outside. Instead, the water which has been saved in the pond provides sufficient supply of water to the institution. There are 7 bore wells which help to get approximately 5000 to 10000 liters every day. In order to recharge the bore wells, there are around 50 pits which are constructed in different dimensions are filled with coarse gravel for adequate infiltration of water. This helps in increasing the ground water level.




One of the open bore well recharge pits behind Ganga Block






**Water Tank on Hostel building Terrace**






Sewage Treatment Plant Unit-I








Waste Water Recycling Unit behind the Hostel






Garden area with water tap




Water and drainage pipes in Main building
